APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

All surfaces must be clean, dry and free of all loose materials. Apply with a standard caulking gun. Cut the nozzle to desired bead size and puncture the inner seal. Apply at a 45% angle using constant pressure. For ease of gunning, use at room temperature. Tool or join surfaces for sealing before material skins. Support tooled or joined surfaces for 8 hours minimum. Use Mineral Spirits or VM&P Naphtha to remove excess material before skin forms. Clean up with VM&P Naphtha or Mineral Spirits.

LIMITATIONS:

All surfaces to be sealed or bonded must be clean and dry and free from contaminants. Primer may be required for certain surfaces.

Ruscoe Premium Butyl Sealant is not recommended for use in window glazing applications or hidden joint details, which require a non-skinning, non-hardening sealant.
